Tom Owen received 25 patents issued during his 34 year career as an electrical engineer at Southwest Research Institute and has received 10 patents as a private consulting engineer since retiring from SwRI in 1994.

Additionally, he currently has 5 patents pending! He will describe the invention and patent aspect of his career and will illustrate a number of successful devices and systems that were reduced to practice for SwRI R&D clients and others. Two of these patents received R&D 100 Awards in 1978 and 1999 and two of them are currently licensed for commercial use.
