



Go Film Yourself: From Prototype to Consumer Product Chris Boyle

Chris Boyle, founder and CEO of SOLOSHOT, Inc, will be our speaker for March 11, 2015. A serial inventor with 38 issued patents, Chris, originally from Queens NY, will discuss how he went from biomedical engineer to starting a consumer robotics company in San Antonio. After a successful exit from his first medical device company, also based in San Antonio, Chris, a long time surfer, kiteboarder and wanderer, left San Antonio to chase waves. Dissatisfied with the way traveling surfers' filmed the surf, Chris had the idea for SOLOSHOT - a robotic cameraman that could always keep it's subject in the shot even at long distances. Chris ultimately returned to San Antonio with a prototype in hand to assemble a team to turn that prototype into a consumer product they would manufacture themselves.

Fast forward to 2015. Chris and his team have won numerous awards from Chase, Google and Lexus, has been featured on the Discovery Channel and Fast Company and their product has even been used to create new television shows for the National Geographic Channel. Chris will tell the story of how SOLOSHOT came to be, why he decided to manufacture the product on home turf and the many ways it's changing the way people capture video of themselves doing what they love.

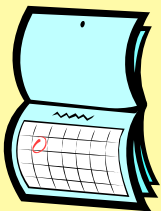
