Dr. Tarbutton left his tenured teaching position to join Bravo Team (a company he founded in 2018). Bravo Team now has 32 employees (mostly engineers) and helps many individuals and companies create new machines and products. He is currently manufacturing and selling the Bravo Walk - a product he invented. Last year he helped 50 companies innovate on 70 projects. He has an 8300 square foot design studio and machine/fab shop to support rapid development of ideas into physical artifacts.

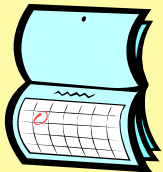
