Patrick helped start www.InfoGlide.com, an enterprise software company that helps fight crime across the world. They developed the Similarity Search Engine, a data mining tool that helps identify and uncover criminal organizations including Money Launderers, Terrorists and Fraud Rings. He will explain how, before he was 27, he sold an Enterprise Technology solution to State Farm, GEICO, USAA, EBAY, AOL, raised over \$18 million in Venture Capital and helped convict the largest Property and Casualty fraud ring in U.S. history ever prosecuted under RICO Statutes.

Mr. McCluskey will share how he used his techniques to gain entry into Fortune 500 companies to help NextEngine's sell their 3D Desktop Scanning technology to NextEngine's first Fortune 500 customers and helped raise \$20 million in Venture Capital during the technology bust of the early 2000's. www.NextEngine.com

He will also share his story on how in 2004 he started www.ExerciseFriends.com, a social network that grew to be ranked the 5th most popular fitness site in the world in less than a year and how he then delivered his community in a Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) model to Time Warner as white label community for Health Magazine with over 1.2 million paid subscribers.

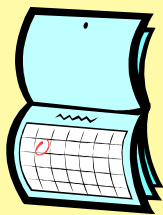
