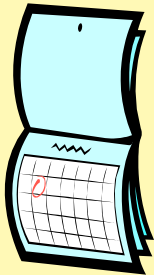

1. Wayne Simonton, a former military and retired airline captain, and an avid bowhunter, invented one of the highest quality, most durable, and precisely manufactured lighted arrow nocks in the industry. Visit, www.tracerarrow.com

Stuart Minica, a 2006 Modern Marvels Invent Now Challenge semi-finalist, with his Magnetic Levitation Arrow Rest will describe his journey from idea, to patent, to manufacturing, to retailers like Cabela’s and Bass Pro Shop. The Air-Rest uses a magnetic insert which is repelled by the magnets in the bow rest to levitate and center an arrow. Visit www.air-rest.com
3. Ralph Moore has been in the crossbow industry for the past thirty years. He has designed, developed and manufactured a new and improved cross-bow, an automatic loading system using a clip for storing arrows, and an improved guiding track for faster, more accurate firing.
